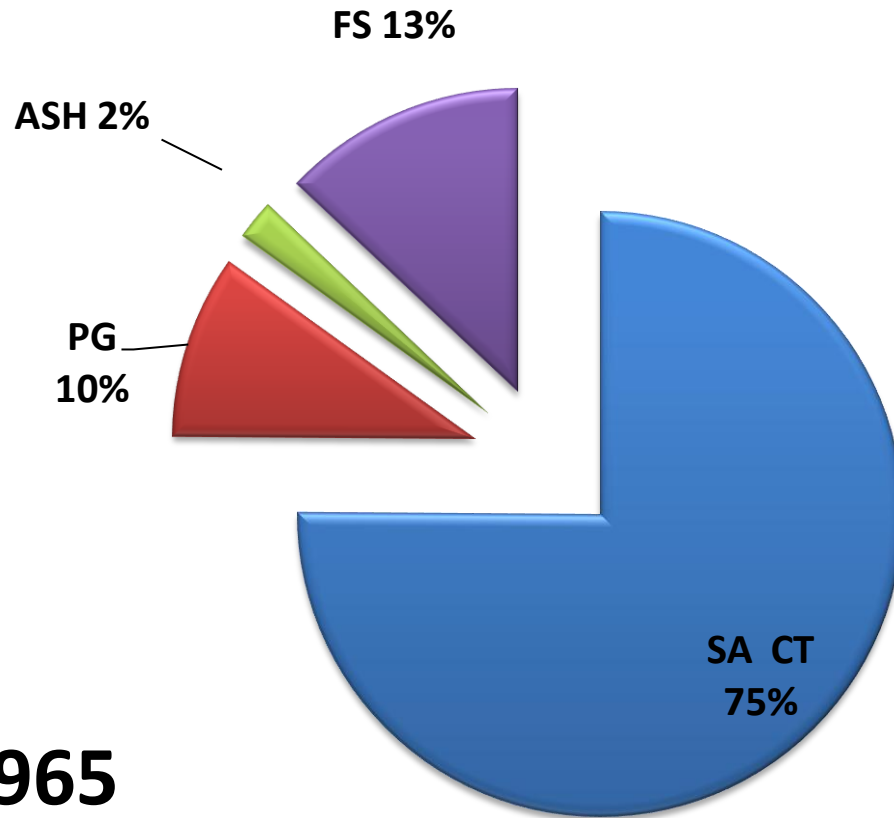

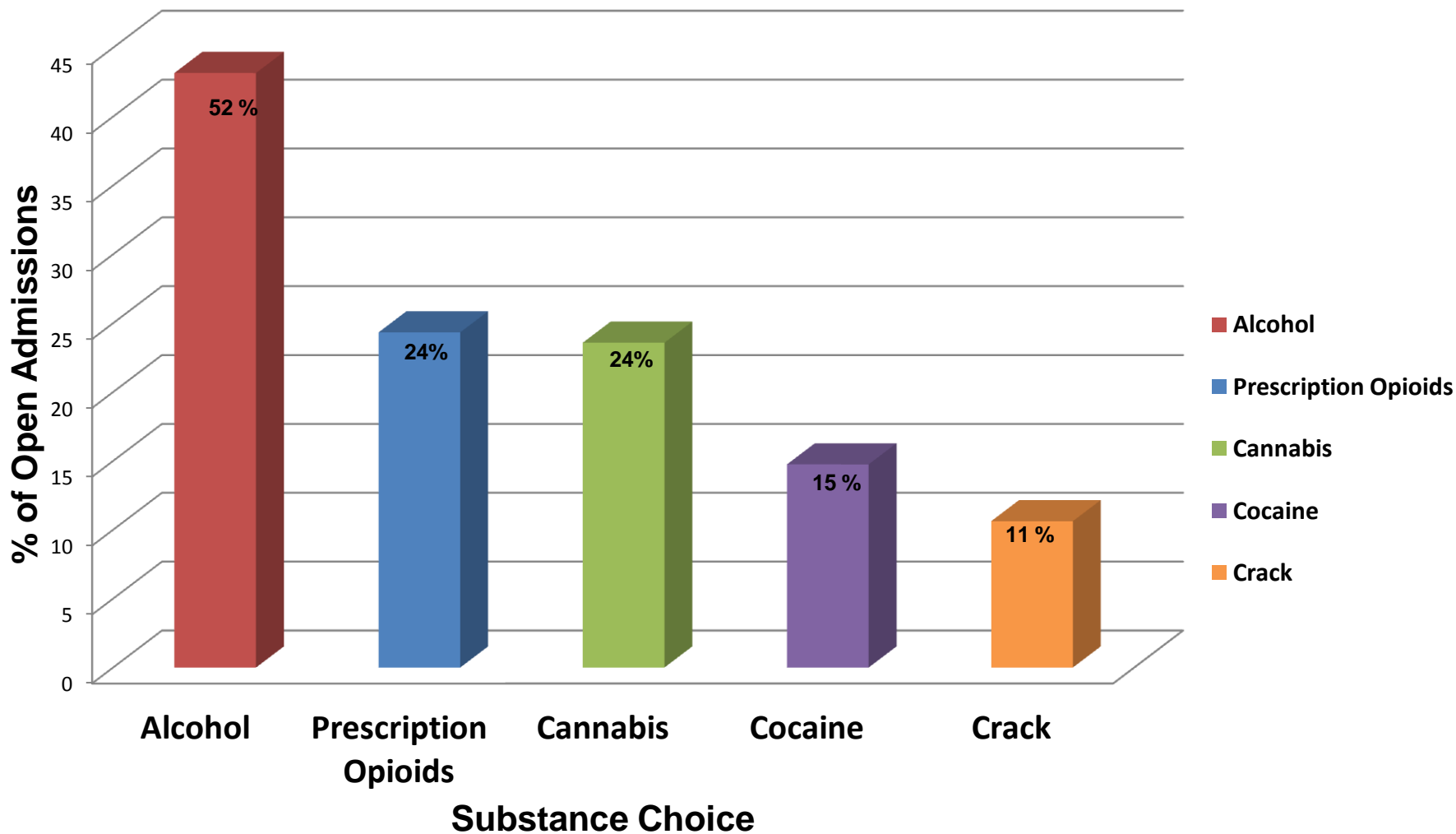
Trend: Intensive & Specialized Work

- **Addiction Supportive Housing:**
 - 42 individual clients + processed applications ,
community development
- **London Drug Treatment Court:**
 - treatment for 18 individuals, and overall court support
- **Fresh Start :**
 - 248 individuals, very collaborative with OW teams
- **heartspace**
 - 185 parents (including 3 men) and 161 children

Groups

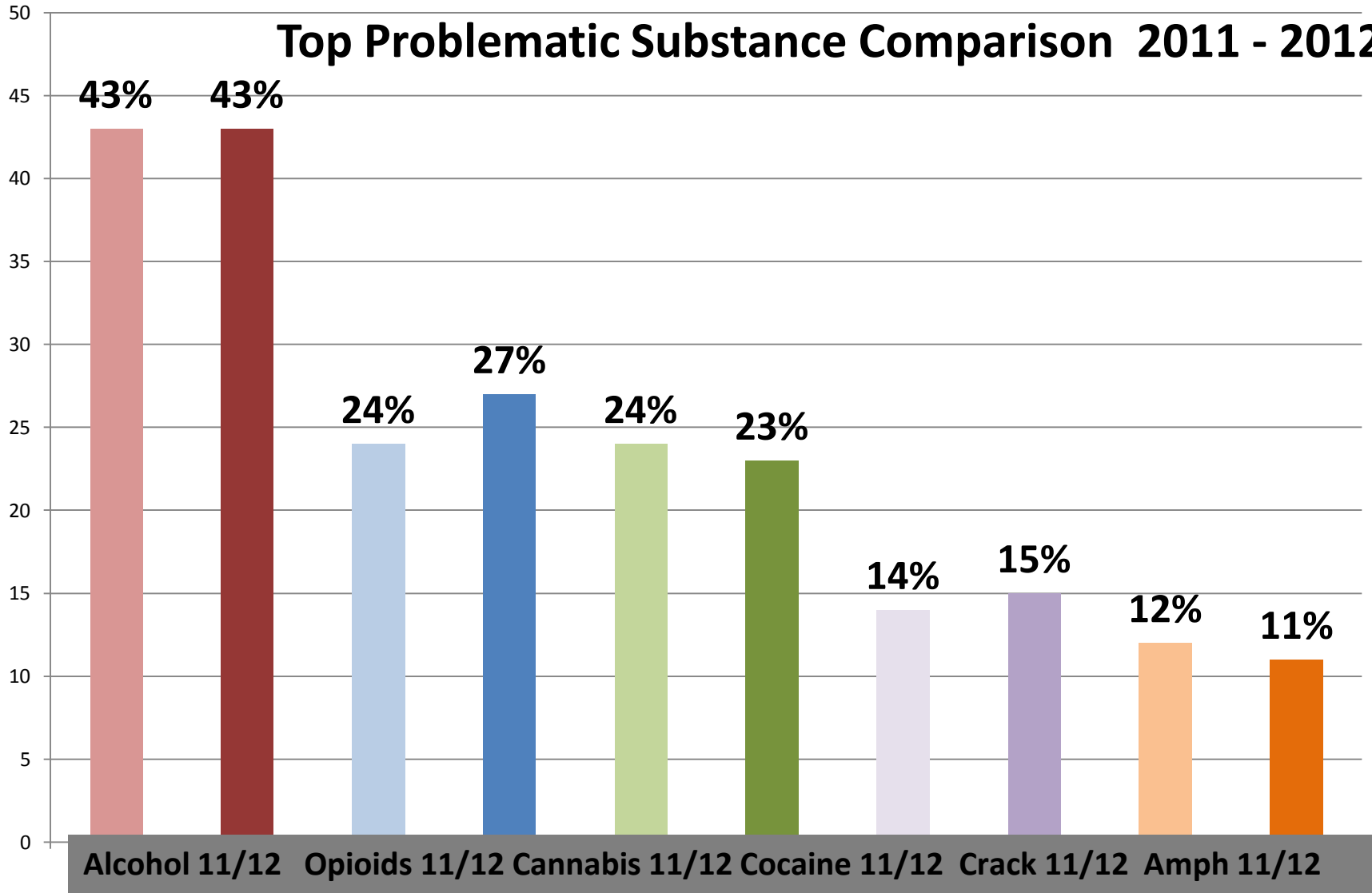
- 131 Initial Assessment Groups served approx. 1100 * individuals
 - Groups include Walk In Intake in London and Oxford County
 - 1272 therapeutic and/or psycho-educational group sessions across programs (minimum of 4/day)
 - 27 informational groups (not awareness/prevention)
- * includes those who “bypassed” group due to special need

Top 5 Problem Substances for ALL Open Admissions

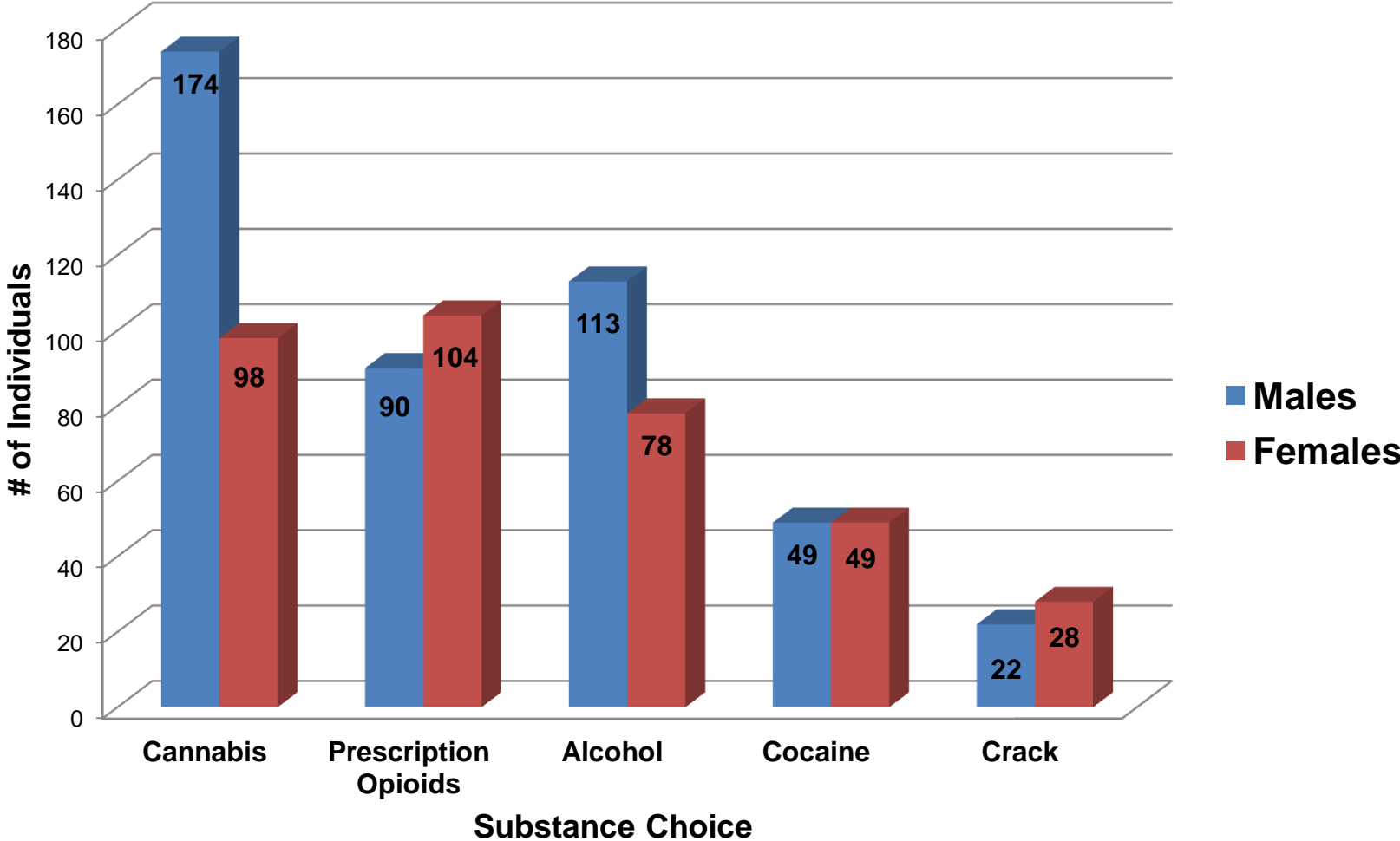

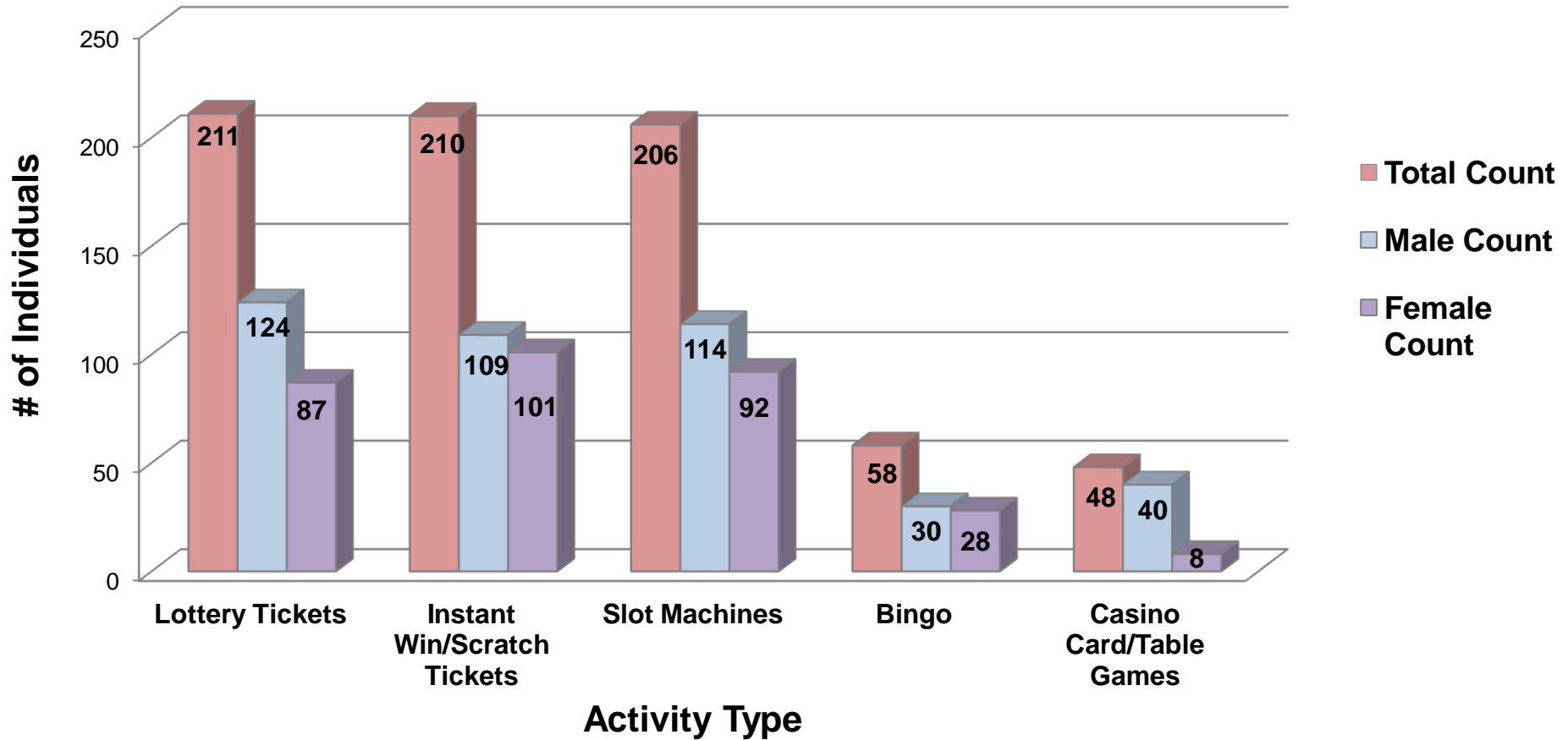
Top Problematic Substance Comparison 2011 - 2012



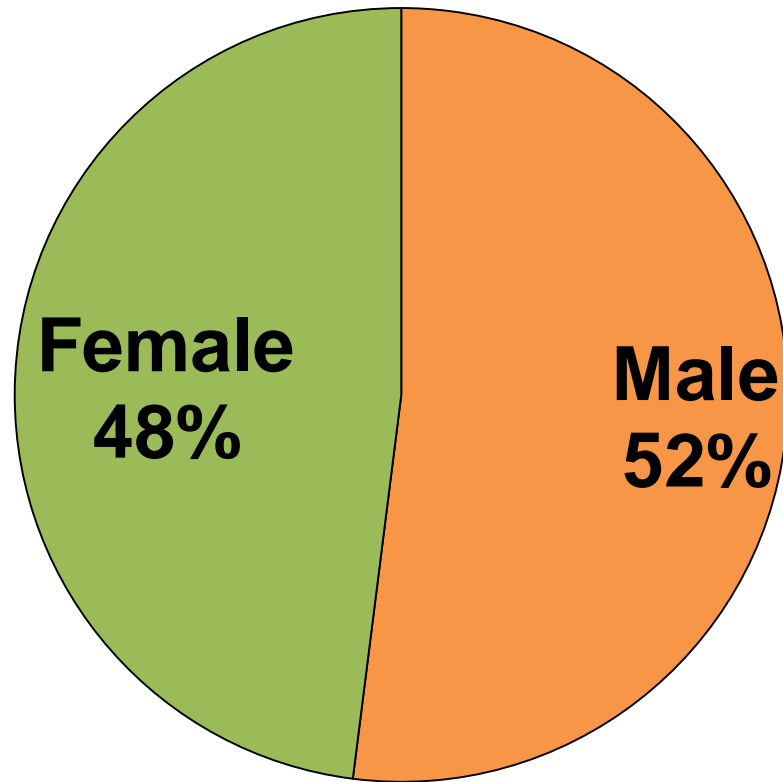
Top Problem Substances for ALL Admissions Aged 16 and Under - 24 Years Old

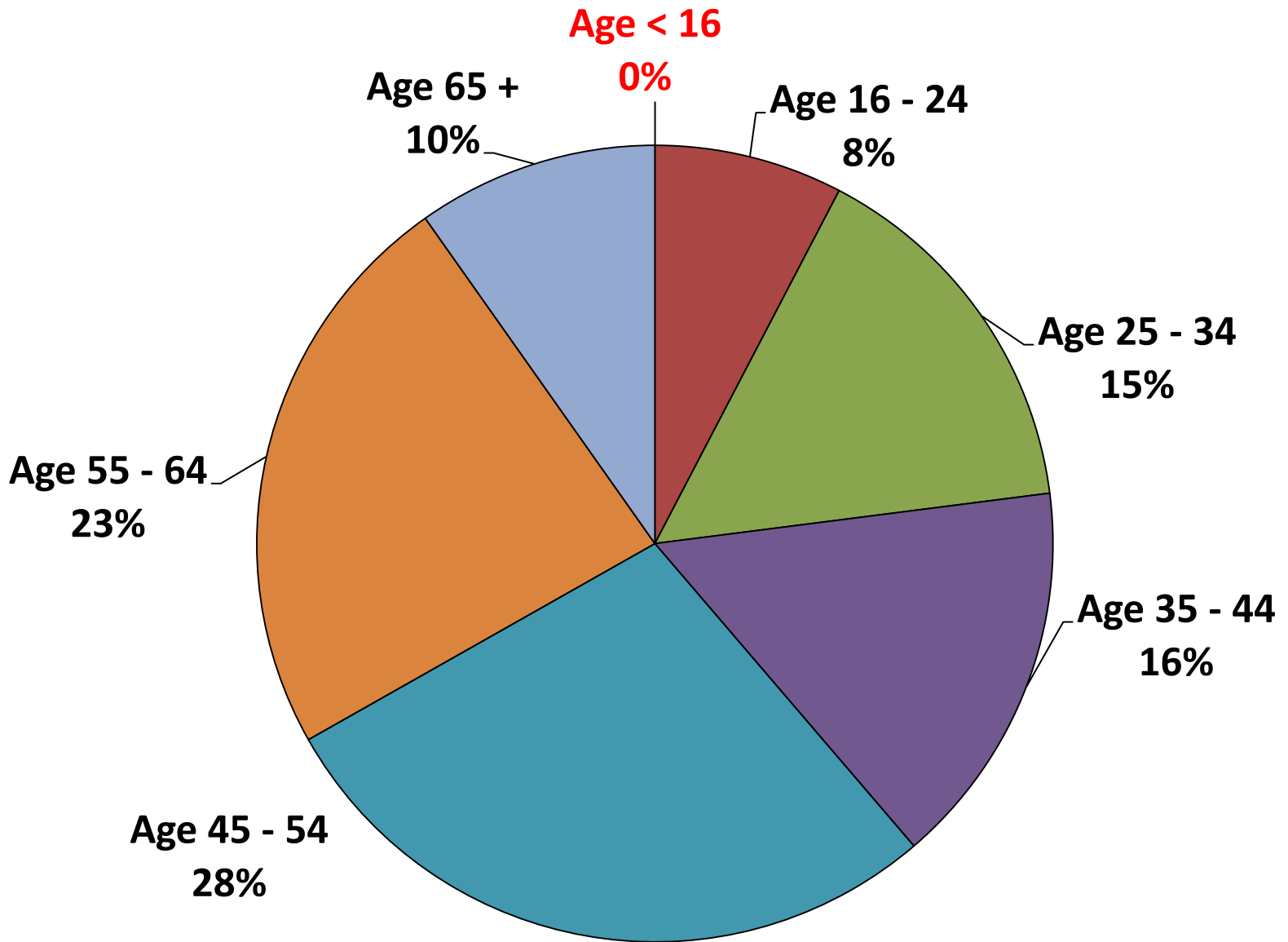


Top 5 Gambling Activities Reported for ALL Open Admissions



Gambling Identified as a Problem by Gender



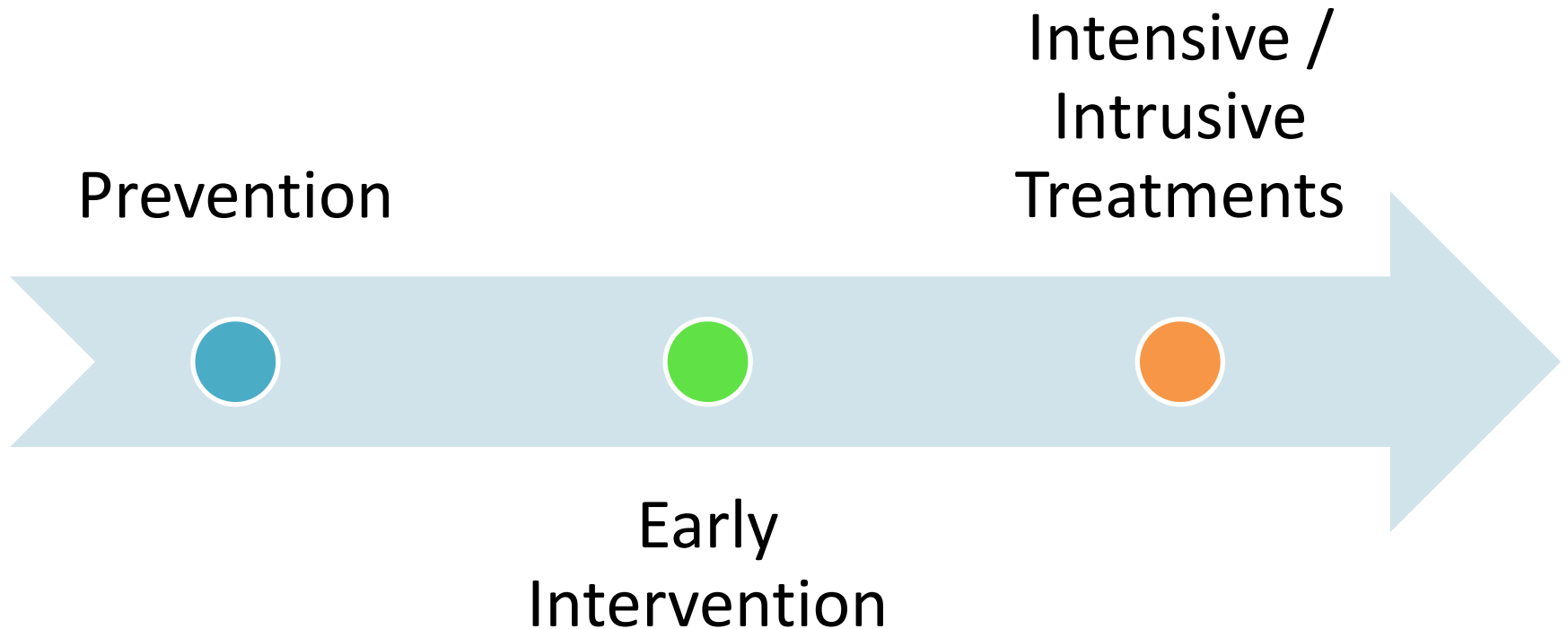


Gambling Identified as a Problem by Age Group

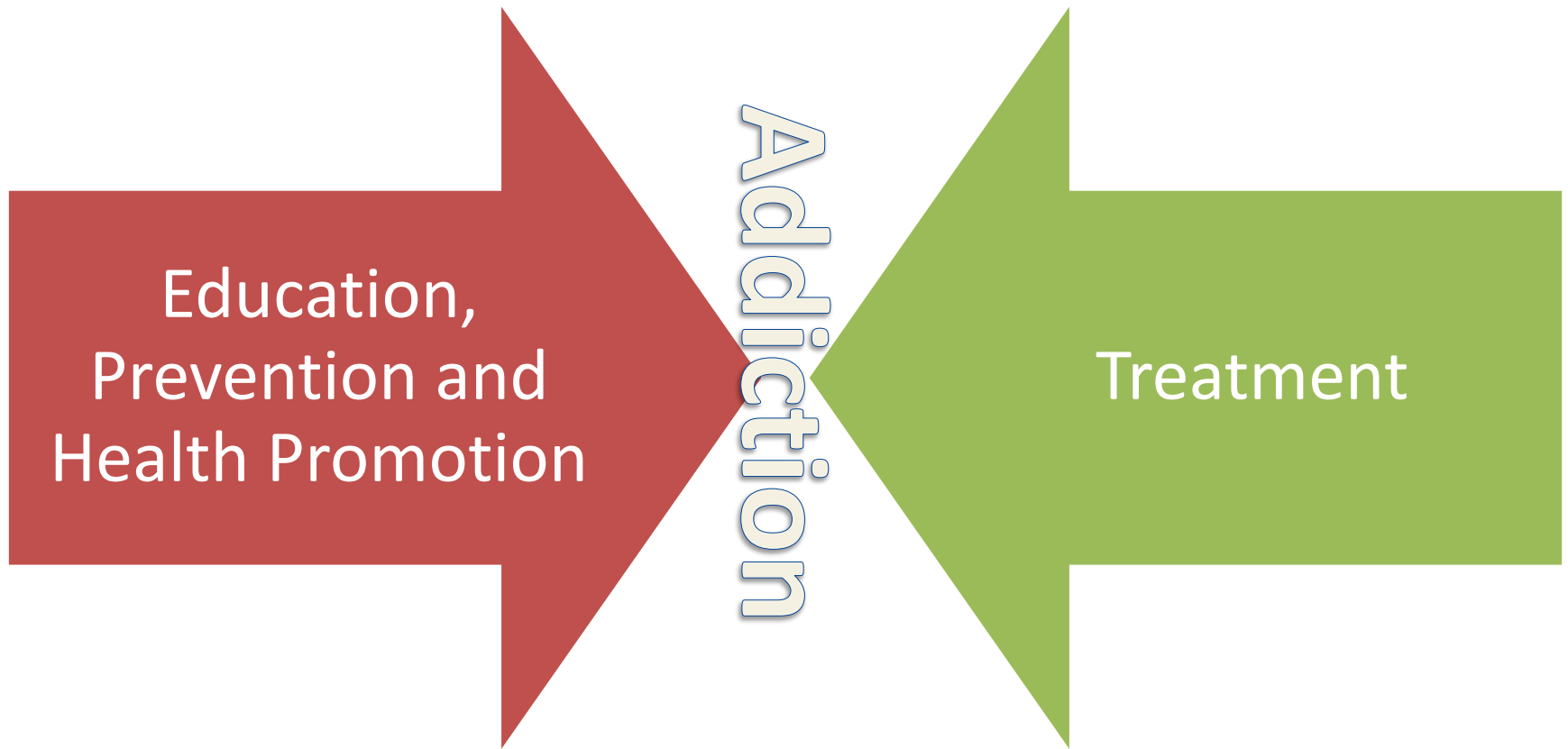
Closing Remarks
